SUMMER HOLIDAY CLUB – HAF PROGRAMME.

We will be open for holiday club every day, Monday to Friday, throughout the Summer holidays (excluding bank holidays) from Friday 21st July to Tuesday 5th September 2023. Alongside our regular club we are once again running the Holiday Activity and Food Programme (HAF) which is supported by Suffolk County Council, giving funded places for children in receipt of benefits related free school meals. These sessions run from 10am to 3pm each day and includes a 2-course cooked lunch. As usual, we're planning a packed programme of activities including free play, arts & crafts, quiet games, football & rounders on the field plus there are additional workshops from outside companies.
